## NEW DATA ELEMENTS -Financial Information Form

New data elements have been added to the health insurance drop down menu.

**UBH - United Behavioral Health – select this code only when a client has been approved by United Behavioral Health for payment of services and is participating in Intensive Outpatient treatment.**
